

## ***SELECTBOARD MEETING MINUTES MARCH 15, 2023***

Attendance: Rose Hill, Jeff Trafton, Charles Greenberg, Doreen Berry, Jonny Hazard, Gary Hazard, Wendy Trafton, and Greg Falzetta

Jeff called the meeting to order with the pledge of allegiance.

### **CHECKING**

*General Checking - \$50,485.78*

*Repurchase – \$679,447.65*

**Minutes** were read from 3/1/2023 meeting. Jeff made a motion to accept the minutes Charles 2<sup>nd</sup> motion passes 3-0

**Fire Dept:** No representative came from the FD, Mike Dionne needs to come in and get his laptop , Rose will notify.

**Roads:** Roy Greely called the office to see if he is needed to do the roadside mowing for 2023. His rate has stayed the same \$2,500.00. Doreen said that I should call him after Town Meeting.

**Sand and salt shed update:** The door has still not been hooked up to the electricity, will reach out to Nathan Wren to see when he can be there

Alfred put the excess sand into the shed over the past weekend and mixed, is confident that this will get us through the winter.

### **Town Office:**

The new generator has been installed. Ideal electric will return to hook to propane, they were missing a fitting. Rose will get pictures to advertise the bid of the old generator and place in appropriate places.

The Rebecca Lewis Fund was discussed in great detail. The will had been found and read with the details of the purpose of the account. Still many unknowns Rose will contact Bangor Savings and Keel the auditor to find more information. The proposed article for the Town meeting Warrant will stay and go before the Town Body to be voted on.

Website contract is up for renewal the cost is considerably higher; this will be tabled until rose can find more details on the past contract.

Snow Removal Contract was brought up; Alfred Wren would prefer to have a 2-3 year contract to plow when/if he places a bid, to ensure that his investments into plowing equipment will not be for nothing. His concern is that with the Public Works idea that he will not get this from the Town. Greg Falzetta had polled the Select Board to evaluate Alfred's job performance form this past season. All board members had high remarks and think he performed his duties well. Doreen said that Alfred can put in his bid and request his own terms as to length of the contract, decision would be made at bid opening time.

The plow contracts will be updated with the addition of the need to have a bond for any bid over \$125,000 (state statute) and change some of the verbiage. The bid notice will go to Rolling Thunder, Town website and out on social media. Bids are due back at the Town office by noon April 17, 2023 to be opened and reviewed on April 19, 2023 @ the Select Board meeting.

Jeff made a motion to review the warrants, Doreen 2<sup>nd</sup> Warrants reviewed Jeff made motion to accept and sign the warrants, Charles 2<sup>nd</sup> motion passes warrants signed.

Jeff made a motion to adjourn, Doreen 2<sup>nd</sup> motion passes 3-0 adjournment 7.55 p.m.
